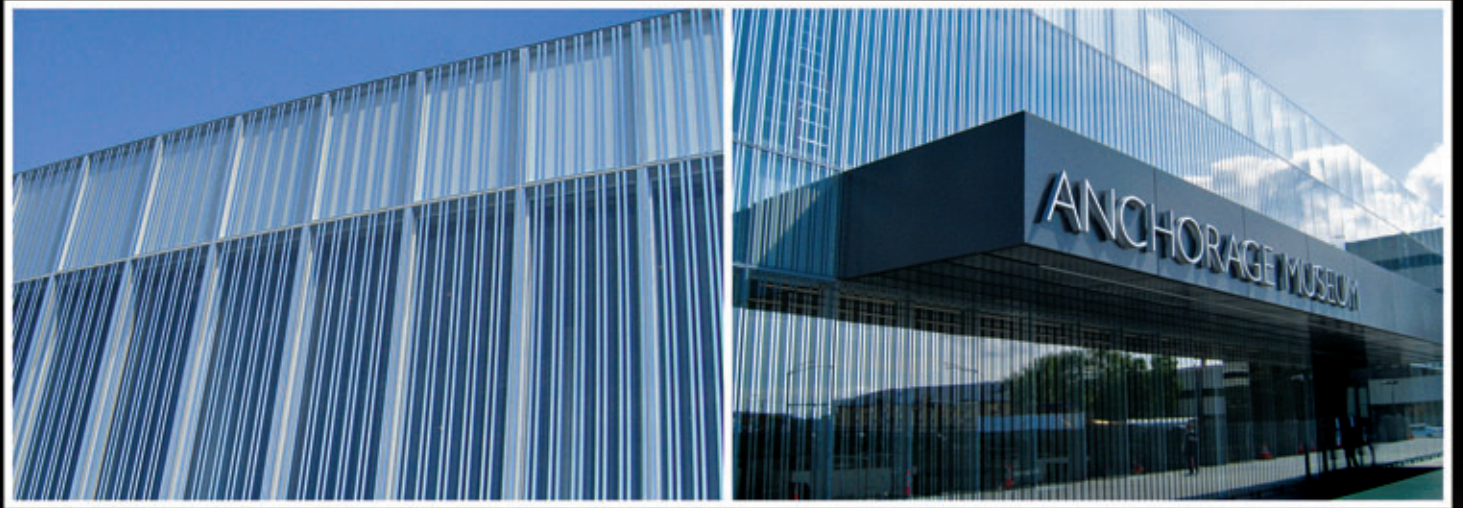

DESCRIPTION

The Architect's aesthetic vision coupled with the extreme climatic conditions in Alaska demanded that the design from Overgaard resist significant structural thermal movement, while ensuring an energy efficient environment within the building. The result was a unique structure with an appealing reflective appearance when viewed externally, but a non-reflective clear anodized appearance from within.

KEY ATTRIBUTES

- 6000 mm² silk screen IGU in a unitised curtain wall
- 6000 mm² laminated glass units
- Mirrored frit on the number #2 surface of the outboard lite that:
 - creates a reflective appearance from the exterior
 - creates a non-reflective clear anodized appearance from the interior
 - results in reflection, transparency and shading
- Curtain wall features integrated automatic roller blinds that adjust to the sun
